September 10, 2009 - May 10, 2010

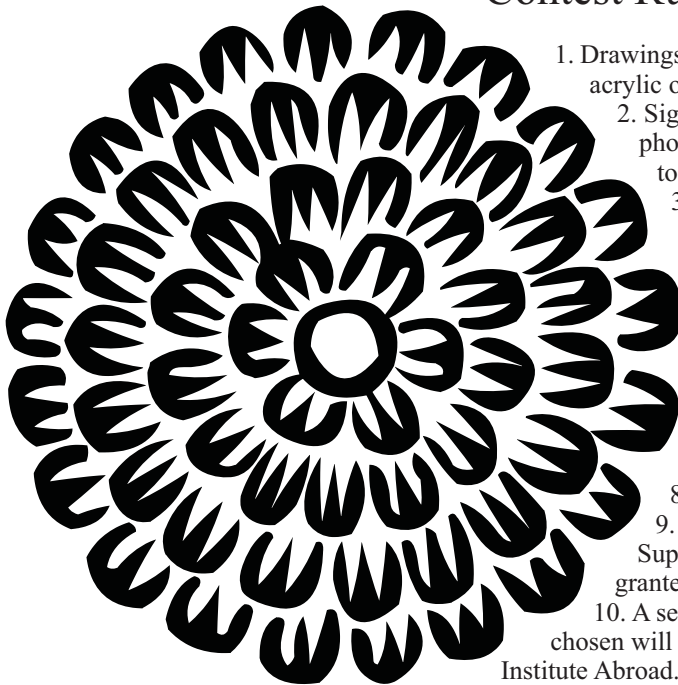

Contest Rules



1. Drawings should be on 12" x 12" cardboard created in pencil, watercolors, crayons, acrylic or any medium desired.
2. Sign and date your work. On the reverse side write your full name, age, address, phone number, e-mail (if available), school name, and name of the library close to you.
3. Drawings will be accepted at any Dallas Public Library location, including the Bookmobile, until Saturday, May 10, 2010.
4. Art judges, specialists in art, will select the best 9 works in each category.
5. Winners will be recognized by the Mexican General Consulate at the Dallas Public Library, 1515 Young Street.
6. All participants will receive a certificate.
7. Drawings that are copied, traced or that adults helped create, unfinished drawings, and those with incomplete information, as well as those that do not comply with the theme and the required size, will be disqualified.
8. Drawings will not be returned.
9. All rights to drawings will be retained by the Special Fund Patronage in Support of the Program for the Mexican Communities Abroad. The Library is granted permission to use the drawings at its discretion.
10. A selection of the drawings from age categories 7 - 11 will be made and those chosen will participate in the children's contest "Este es mi México" for the Mexican Institute Abroad.
